GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Apply in mid winter when trees or vines are dormant. Spray coverage: A liberal application of the product is required to ensure complete coverage of all eggs.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Pour the required amount of water into the mixing tank and while agitating add the required amount of VICOL WINTER OIL. When using in combination with other pesticides, mix the pesticide first according to the manufacturers instructions, then add VICOL WINTER OIL last. Maintain continuous agitation while spraying.

Protection of Wildlife, Fish, Crustacea and Environment

Do not contaminate streams, rivers or waterways with the chemical or used containers.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS (cont)

COMPATIBILITY

VICOL WINTER OIL should not be tank mixed with any herbicide, insecticide or fungicide except in strict accordance with the manufacturers instructions.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of reach of children.

Store in the closed, original container, in a well ventilated area, out of direct sunlight. Triple, or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsing to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush, or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

RETURNABLE 1000 L CONTAINERS

If returning 1000 L containers do not rinse, instead replace cap and return to designated collection point. In the event of spillage absorb onto sand or chemical absorbent. Remove residue with detergent and hot water. Dispose of by normal waste disposal methods conforming to local authority codes.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Avoid inhalation of spray mists. Use a mask when spraying in combination with other chemicals and refer to their safety directions.

FIRST AID

If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Phone Australia 131126). If swallowed, DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water.
